



## ILAS Studentship 2019/2020 Master of Research in Latin American Studies

### GUIDANCE

#### What is an ILAS Master of Research in Latin American Studies studentship?

This Master's studentship, made available by the Institute of Latin American Studies (ILAS), School of Advanced Study (SAS), is designed to support students wishing to pursue the Master of Research in Latin American Studies at ILAS for entry in 2019/2020 on either a full- or part-time basis.

#### Terms of the award

Successful applicants will receive a fixed amount of £5,000 for full time study or £2,500 for part time study which will be discounted from their tuition fees. Awards are made at the discretion of the Selection Panel and there is no minimum number of awards made in any year. The award is also conditional on the course registering a minimum number of students and may be withdrawn in the unlikely event that the course does not proceed.

#### Eligibility

- Applicants must have applied for a place on the Master of Research in Latin American Studies at the Institute of Latin American Studies (ILAS), School of Advanced Study, for entry in 2018/2019 on either a full- or part-time basis by Monday 01 July 2019.
- Awards are open to Home, EU and Overseas students.
- Applicants must be self-funded. Please note that the award may be withdrawn if a student receives equivalent funding (i.e. tuition fee support) elsewhere.

#### Criteria

- The primary selection criterion is academic merit as evidenced by previous academic achievement.
- Successful applicants will also demonstrate a genuine enthusiasm for their proposed area of study and a desire to contribute to the intellectual life of the Institute.
